
Directions





We will further develop the standards of medical treatment by pursuing front-line treatment for cancer from the viewpoint of patients and making efforts to contribute to the international medical society.

Well-Equipped Facilities

-We have 12 surgery (operating) rooms, 10 ICU beds, 34 beds for chemotherapy(anti-cancer treatment).
 -We also have advanced medical equipment such as 3 Linacs (Linear Accelerators), 3 MRIs and a rehabilitation room, as well as a garden of 238 m².

Enhancing Amenities

The size of patient's rooms has been enlarged.

Private room: About 20 m² (approx.1.5 times larger)

4-Patient room: About 45 m² (approx. 1.5 times larger)

Contribution to International Medical Society

We promote medical collaboration in fields such as personnel exchanges and joint research.

We are currently collaborating with six institutions in five countries that we have concluded international agreements concerning medical exchanges (As of April 2010)

Cancer Treatment Available After Work

Linacs (Linear accelerators) available until 7:30pm. We started a consultation service for cancer patients to find a job. Professional staff from "Hello Work", National Employment Service Center, and the Osaka Occupational Health Support Center come to our hospital to give advice for cancer patients.

Stress Management of Cancer Patients

Nutrition: We provide nutritious and delicious meals to patients, with 30 % of ingredients originating from Osaka.

Art: Many modern artworks are exhibited in the hospital.

Laugh: "Study of laughter as a cancer treatment" - the first of its kind in Japan.

Classical Music: We are also studying the use of classical music for cancer treatment in collaboration with four major archestres in Osaka.

Next Generation Cancer Treatment Development Center "Cancer Cell Port"

In order to improve outcomes from cancer treatment, we serve as the bridge between our hospital and laboratory, and support to collect and offer the biological specimen of the patients (Cancer Cell Port), etc..
